1. Learned counsel representing State pointed out that as per instructions received by her, petitioner-Feku is acquitted vide judgement dated 05.08.2025 in FIR No.0152 dated 09.06.2023, registered under Sections 137(2), 87, 65(2) of BNS and Section 6 of POCSO Act, (offence under Section 376 (A,B) of IPC, Section 6 of POCSO Act and Section 9, 10 of Prohibition of Child Marriage Act were added later on), at Police Station Phillaur, District Jalandhar Rural.
2. In view of the aforesaid factual position, learned counsel for petitioner states that he does not want to pursue the present regular bail petition and accordingly withdraws the same.
3. In view of the statement, present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn having rendered infructuous.
