Prayer in this petition filed under Section 528 of Bhartiya Nyaya Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, is for quashing of Rapat No.23, dated 30.09.2024, under Sections 115(2), 118(1), 126(3), 303(2), 191(3) and 190 of BNS, 2023, registered at Police Sultanpur Lodhi, Tehsil and District Kapurthala (Annexure P-3) in FIR No.136, dated 18.07.2024, under Sections 115(2), 118(1), 126(2), 194(2), 351(3), 191(3), 190 and 109 of BNS, 2023, Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, Tehsil and District Kapurthala (Annexure P-2) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 26.12.2024 (Annexure P-4).

In compliance of order dated 17.02.2025, short reply by way of affidavit dated 03.03.2025 of Gurmeet Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of



Police, Sub-Division Sultanpur Lodhi, Kapurthala, on behalf of respondent No.1-State, has been filed in Court today, which is taken on record.

Vakalatnama filed on behalf of respondents No.2 to 6 in Court today, is taken on record.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioners are seeking partial quashing of FIR in question which is against the settled ratio of law laid down by the Division Bench of Court in **CRM-M-48043-2023** titled as ***Rakesh Das Versus State of Haryana and another***, decided on 12.11.2024.

In view of the law laid down by the Hon'ble Division Bench in **CRM-M-48043-2023** (supra), no ground for interference is made out in the present petition and the same stand dismissed accordingly.
