1. Present petition has been filed *inter alia* praying for issuance of appropriate direction to the respondents No.1 to 4 for taking action in pursuance to the FIR No.78 dated 18.09.2019 under Sections 354, 376, 379-B, 506, 120-B of IPC at Women Police Station District Palwal.

2. Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for respondents No.5 to 7 have submitted that a cancellation report has already been filed before the learned trial Court and the petitioner despite knowing about the same for the last 5 years has not filed any protest petition and the cancellation report is still pending for 02.08.2025. Since prayer made in the



present petition is only with regard to the issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to take action in pursuance to FIR No.78 dated 18.09.2019 under Sections 354, 376, 379-B, 506, 120-B of IPC at Women Police Station District Palwal, which has already been settled and the prayer does not survive.

3. In view of the above, present petition stands disposed of accordingly with liberty to the petitioner to seek appropriate remedy available to her in accordance with law.

4. Since the main case has been decided, pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stands also disposed of.
