1. Present writ petition was filed 24 years ago for directing respondents No. 1 and 2 to prosecute respondent No.4 under Section 29 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 with a further direction to issue the recovery certificate to the Collector, Sirsa for affecting the amount due to the petitioner as arrears of land revenue.
2. Upon notice of motion, the respondents have filed the reply wherein, the respondents have stated that keeping in view the pendency of the issue between the parties before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India wherein, the status quo order was granted vide order dated 28.02.2000, the prayer of the petitioner could not be granted.
3. The present writ petition was admitted.
4. No one has appeared on behalf of the petitioner and nothing has been brought to the notice of this Court as to whether the present petition survives as of now or not.
5. Keeping in view the above, the present writ petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
