Petitioner has filed instant petition under Section 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of regular bail in FIR No.63 dated 29.05.2024, under Sections 376/506 IPC registered at Police Station Division No.5 and District Jalandhar.

Today, case was fixed for arguments. At this stage, learned counsel for petitioner states that trial is at fag end and as per his instructions, arguments are already advanced and the order is to be pronounced.
