The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya
Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for issuance of directions to respondents No.2
& 3 to furnish status report of FIR No.0072 dated 01.09.2024 under Sections
306/380/323/147/149/120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station Ghanaur,
District Patiala (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that marriage
of the son (deceased) of the petitioner with respondent No.4 was solemnized in
the year 2015. However, a dispute has arisen between them due to their
inability to conceive. Respondent No.4 i.e. the wife of the son of the petitioner
influenced by certain individuals and she used to rejoin her matrimonial home
and despite the repeated requests of the son of the petitioner, respondent No.4
remained adamant and pushed him into despair. On 28.08.2022, the son of the
petitioner ended his life. It is further submitted that the petitioner later on came
to know that respondent No.4 was engaged in an illicit affair with one Amarjit
Singh-respondent No.5 which is evidenced by her pregnancy and respondents

No.6 & 7 were aware of this betrayal, thereafter, respondent No.4 misled the petitioner into a fraudulent settlement and extorted Rs.10 lakh from him. Thereafter, the petitioner has already made a representation dated 05.01.2025 (Annexure P-2) but no action has been taken so far.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated 05.01.2025 (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to the official respondents only.

Mr. Subhash Godara, Addl.A.G., Punjab, puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents-State and copy of the petition has been supplied in the Court.

Keeping in view the prayer made by the petitioner and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated 05.01.2025 (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner and take appropriate steps including grant of any protection to the petitioner in view of the apprehension, if any, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
