BHARAT BHUSHAN VS RAM KISHAN AND ORS

Mr. Jaiveer Singh Malik, Advocate appeared and filed Power of Attorney on behalf of the appellant, which is taken on record.

As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellant(s), learned counsel and representative of the respondent-Insurance Company (separately recorded) a sum of Rs.2,30,000/- (Rupees Two Lakh Thirty Thousand only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellant(s) in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellant(s), the enhanced amount be paid to the appellant(s)/claimant(s) in the same proportion as given by the Tribunal.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance-Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for Rs.2,30,000/- in the name of the appellant(s)/claimant(s) with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 60 days, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the respondent-Insurance Company. The appellant(s) counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
