The instant petition has been preferred by the petitioner for seeking issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release the complete retiral benefits of the petitioner including full pension, gratuity etc. and a further prayer to direct the respondents to decide the representations-cum-legal notices dated 18.07.2024 (Annexures P-3 and P-4 respectively).

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that, at this juncture, the petitioner would be satisfied in case respondent No.3-Director General Health Services, Panchkula, Haryana is directed to decide the legal notice dated 18.07.2024 (Annexure P-3 and P-4 respectively) and the grievance espoused by the petitioner therein by



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passing a speaking order thereupon in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Tanisha Peshawaria, DAG, Haryana appears on behalf of the respondents and submits she has no objection to the aforesaid prayer being granted.

5. Accordingly, with the consent of the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of and respondent No.3-Director General Health Services, Panchkula, Haryana, is directed to decide the legal notice dated 18.07.2024 (Annexure P-3 and P-4 respectively) and to pass a reasoned and speaking order thereupon in accordance with law preferably within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

6. Needless to mention that in the event the entitlement of the petitioner is established as per law, the payment due to the petitioner shall be released expeditiously and preferably within a further period of two months.
