1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.286 dated 06.08.2024, under Sections 303 of BNS, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, District Hisar, Haryana.
2. Vide order dated 05.03.2025, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 05.03.2025, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.
4. Learned counsel for respondent No.2/complainant has opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.
