1. The petitioner is an association of employees and through the instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 24.01.2000 whereby its claim for city compensatory allowance has been declined.

2. Learned State counsel submits that claim of petitioner was based upon letter of finance department which stands withdrawn vide memo dated 25.07.2001, thus, claim of the petitioner does not survive. The memo dated 25.07.2001 is not under challenge, thus, instant petition has rendered infructuous

3. In the wake of statement of learned State counsel, the present petition stands disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

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4. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. It is at liberty to move an appropriate application within three months, if cause survives.
