1. Present petition has been filed under Section 483 of BNSS, seeking regular bail in case FIR No.154 dated 12.05.2010, under Sections 148, 149 and 307 IPC and Sections 25, 59 and 25(54) of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Shona, District Gurugram.

2. This Court is informed that despite registration of FIR in the year 2010 under the compelling circumstances, learned trial Court had to conduct two different trials and petitioner's trial is the third one in consequence of the non-joining of the proceedings and declaring him a proclaimed offender. In the First round of the trial only accused-Kushi Ram and Bhagat Singh were tried and on account of turning the witnesses hostile, they were acquitted vide judgment dated 21.12.2010. In the second round of the trial accused-Rohit was acquitted on 19.07.2011 and thereupon in the third round of trial accused- Shakti @ Dholu was tried and then acquitted vide judgment dated 30.11.2015. It is the fourth trial

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in sequence after registration of the case that petitioner is facing after being declared a Proclaimed person twice.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is in custody since 18.11.2024 and has undergone substantial period of sentence. Counsel further submits that culmination of trial is likely to take considerable time, thus prays for regular bail.

4. This Court does not find any substance in the submissions, moreover, present bail petition is disposed of with a direction to learned trial Court to culminate the trial within a period of 06 months from today.
