1. The petitioners through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India are seeking direction to the respondents to frame Service Rules for the post of Dairymen.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that instant petition was filed in 2001 seeking direction to respondents to frame Service Rules, however, he has no instructions from his clients.
