Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.549 dated 05.12.2024, registered under Sections 115, 118(1), 3(5), 351(2) of BNS, 2023 (Section 118(2) of BNS, 2023 added lateron), at Police Station Civil Lines, Sirsa, District Sirsa.

Vide order dated 26.03.2025, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 26.03.2025, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Satyabir Singh, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 26.03.2025 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.
