By way of present petition filed under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023, petitioners seek anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as under:

460	27.10.2023	307, 148, 149 of IPC and 25 and 27 of Arms Act (Section 25 of Arms Act has been deleted later on)	Goindwal Sahib, District Tarn Taran.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance to the order dated 03.03.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioners have already joined the investigation and as such prayed for confirming the interim bail granted vide order dated 03.03.2025.
3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Baljinder Singh, intimates the Court that the petitioners have joined investigation and



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are neither required for further investigation nor for any custodial interrogation.

4. During the course of hearing on 03.03.2025, following order was passed:

“2. Heard.

3. After considering the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioners and learned State counsel, it is apparent that no specific overt act is attributed to the petitioners except for alleged slap on the person of Karanbir Singh. Admittedly, the petitioners have no criminal antecedents and all other co-accused have since been granted concession of bail. In these circumstances, without commenting on the merits of the case, it is deemed appropriate that the petitioners should join the investigation before deciding the petition on merits.

4. Accordingly, the petitioners are hereby directed to join investigation within seven days from today and in the event of their arrest, they are ordered to be released on interim bail on their furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. They shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) of BNSS, 2023.

5. Investigating Officer of the case to remain present along with record on the next date of hearing.

6. List on 20.03.2025.”

5. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioners had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 03.03.2025 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 03.03.2025 is hereby confirmed, subject to

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conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) of BNSS, 2023. Further the petitioners are directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioners; they will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

- 6. The petition stands allowed.
- 7. It is made clear that anything contained hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
