1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of a direction to respondents No.2 to 4 for conducting fair investigation in case of complaint filed by Sohan Singh at Ludhiana, whereby petitioners have been asked to appear at the office of Deputy Commissioner of Police, Rural Ludhiana vide letter dated 12.12.2023 (Annexure P-1).

2. In compliance of the order passed by this Court on 26.02.2024, status report by way of affidavit of Kuldeep Singh Chahal, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4-State has been filed. The same is taken on record. A copy thereof be supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. Learned State counsel refers to the status report and submits that nothing survives in the present petition as the grievance raised by the petitioners, in the present petition, has been substantially redressed. The

veracity of the allegations made by the father-in-law of the grandson of petitioners was examined and it has been concluded that no offence is made out and the representation has been ordered to be sent to record room.

4. In view of the above, present petition stands disposed of as having been rendered as infructuous.
