KULDEEP TIWARI, J.(Oral)

1. Through the instant writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, a prayer is made for issuance of a *mandamus* upon respondent no.3-Foreigners Regional Office (FRRO), to allow the Exit Permit Application dated 05.11.2023 (Annexure P-5), of petitioner no.2, who is Czech Republic Citizen born in India, through surrogacy to petitioner no.1 and Adam Zahradnik.
2. Learned counsel for respondents-UOI, submits that he has no objection in case a *mandamus* is passed upon the respondents concerned, to decide the application (Annexure P-5), in a time bound manner.
3. In view of the concurrence given by learned counsel for respondents-UOI, the instant petition is **disposed of**, with a *mandamus*

upon competent authority i.e. respondent no.3, to decide the application (*supra*), by passing a speaking order, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
