The instant writ petition has been filed seeking quashing of oral order dated 31.03.2022 whereby the services of the petitioners have been terminated by respondent No.4-Senior Medical Officer, Community Health Centre, Mangali, District Hisar, allegedly by saying that 'your services are not required' despite the fact that respondents No.3 and 4 were duty bound to upload the data of the petitioners on the portal of Haryana Kaushal Rozgar Nigam Limited (HKRNL) as per clause 8.1 of Deployment of Contractual Persons Policy, 2022 dated 30.06.2022 (Annexure P-2).

2 At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the respondent No.4- Senior Medical Officer, Community Health Centre, Mangali, District Hisar, to decide the representation dated 07.11.2024 (Annexure P-6) submitted by the petitioners by passing a speaking and reasoned order in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

3 Notice of motion.

4 Ms. Tanisha Peshawaria, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that she has no objection to the aforesaid prayer being granted.

5 Accordingly, with the consent of the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4-Senior Medical Officer, Community Health Centre, Mangali, District Hisar, to decide the representation dated 07.11.2024 (Annexure P-6) submitted by the petitioners and to pass a speaking and reasoned order thereupon in accordance with law within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order after granting an opportunity of hearing to the petitioners, if prescribed under law.
