1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 02.07.2001 (Annexure P-27) whereby respondent has rejected petitioner's candidature for the post of Constable.

2. The petitioner pursuant to advertisement of 2001 applied for the post of Constable. She was rejected on the ground that she could not qualify Physical Efficiency Test. She was not called for interview. She claims that respondent No.3-Attar Singh Ahlawat, then Senior Superintendent of Police, Rohtak assured her that she would be selected. He called her at his residence and tried to molest her. She filed a criminal complaint against him.

3. On the asking of Court, learned counsel for the petitioner expressed his inability to disclose status of criminal complaint filed by the petitioner against respondent No.3.



4. From the reply it comes out that candidature of petitioner was rejected on the ground that she failed to qualify Physical Efficiency Test.

5. A period of 25 years from the date of alleged selection has passed away and the candidature of the petitioner has been rejected on the ground that she did not qualify Physical Efficiency Test. There is nothing on record disclosing the outcome of alleged complaint lodged by the petitioner against respondent No.3. This Court, at this belated stage, does not find it just to direct the respondent to issue appointment letter to the petitioner. Accordingly, petition is hereby disposed of.

6. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
