1. Present petition has been filed for directing the official respondents to conduct fair, impartial investigation in case FIR No.115 dated 29.08.2024 (Annexure P-1), registered under section 115, 118 (1), 126 (2), 324 (2), 3 (5), of BNS 2023, at police station Kartarpur, District Jalandhar Rural, Gurdaspur against the private respondents No. 5 and 6, as the police official are not adding the relevant offence under section 303 (2) BNS of 2023, at the instances of private respondents No.5 & 6, who are halting the entire process of investigation after taking police officials into their confidence under illegal consideration. Further prayer has been made to conduct fair, impartial investigation/reinvestigation by constituting the SIT or Transfer the investigation to any independent agency except SSP Jalandhar in the cross case GDR No 31 dated 06.09.2024, (Annexure P-2), registered under section 115, 118 (1), 126 (2), 324 (2), 351, 351 (3), of BNS 2023, at police station Kartarpur, District Jalandhar and further for directing the official respondents to decide the Representations dated 15.01.2025 (Annexure P-5), within a fixed time frame.



2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is the complainant in FIR No.115 dated 29.08.2024 (Annexure P-1), however, there is no progress in the investigation till date. He submits that the petitioner has filed a representation dated 15.01.2025 before respondent No.2, however, the same is also not taken into consideration till date.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Sr. D.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. He, on instructions from ASI Iqbal Singh, at the outset, has submitted that the investigation is complete and challan is already presented before the trial Court and now the case is fixed for framing of charges.

5. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to pursue his remedy as available to him under the law.
