1. Short reply/compliance report by way of affidavit of Sh. Rakesh Saini, Estate Officer-I, HSVP, Gurugram on behalf of the respondents has been filed in Court, which is taken on record.

2. Ms. Nihar Bala, Advocate for Mr. Harmanjot Singh Gill, Advocate has filed vakalatnama on behalf of respondents, which is taken on record.

Learned counsel representing the respondents submits that the amount of compensation payable to the petitioners has been sanctioned on 28.02.2025 and the same shall be released to them within three weeks from today.

litigation expenses, immediately i.e. on the first date of listing of revival
application.
