Present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short 'BNSS'), for quashing of order dated 19.10.2013 (P-1) passed by learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Dasuya (for short 'JMIC') in complaint case COMI/353/2013 titled as '*Manoj Kumar versus Ashok Kumar and another*' under Sections 420, 406 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short, 'IPC') whereby petitioner was declared as proclaimed offender.

2. Contends that in compliance of order dated 07.02.2025, costs of Rs.50,000/- has already been deposited and petitioner has joined the proceedings before learned JMIC; thus, the present petition be disposed off as not pressed "at this stage".
