Present application seeking leave to appeal has been filed against the impugned order dated 01.03.2017 passed by learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Guruhar Sahai, dismissing the complaint preferred by appellant under Section 307 read with Section 511, Sections 326, 324, 323 IPC against accused-respondent.
