JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent to release his pension and other retiral dues.

2. The petitioner applied for voluntary retirement and his application was considered w.e.f. 13.09.2024. He claims that respondent has not released his retiral dues.

3. Mr. Aman Dhir, DAG, Punjab who on advance notice is present in Court submits that 50% of pension on provisional basis stands released. GPF also stands released. The remaining pension and other dues would be released as soon as he would submit no dues certificate as well as cases, if any, pending against him are concluded.

4. Mr. Rajesh Gupta, Advocate for the petitioner agrees with aforesaid arrangement.

5. In the wake of statement of both sides, the petition stands



disposed of.

6. The respondent shall endeavor to release remaining benefits as soon as no dues certificate is submitted. The petitioner would also intimate respondent if he has already been acquitted in criminal case.
