1. The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.223 dated 07.10.2024 registered under Section 64 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 at Police Station Mataur, District SAS Nagar.

2. Learned Senior counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 11.02.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from Asi Lakhvir Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for further investigation.



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4. In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the interim relief granted to the petitioner vide order dated 11.02.2025 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of Cr.P.C./482(2) of BNSS, 2023.
