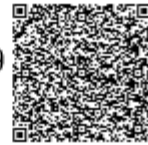

1. In the present petition, the challenge is to the Award dated 16.09.1998 (Annexure P-3) by which, the benefit has been granted that the petitioner be given the difference of wages along with 12% interest.

2. The writ petition was admitted on 03.11.2000 and there is no interim order. Nothing has come on record that the Award challenged in the present petition has not been executed or not.

3. Further, the only grievance raised by the petitioner is that the respondent-Workman was working with the service breaks and not continuity. A bare perusal of the Award would show that the muster rolls were produced, where the working of the petitioner with the respondents for the period starting from the year 1988 stood proved.

3. Once, the working of the respondent-Workman stood proved and that too on the post of Work Munshi, the respondent-Workman was



entitled to the salary of the said post, which had been granted by the Competent Court of Law while passing the impugned Award.

4. No perversity has been pointed out in the impugned Award.
5. No ground is made out for any interference by this Court in the present petition.
6. Dismissed.
7. Pending miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
