The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.316 dated 02.09.2022 under Sections 61/4/2020 of Excise Act and Sections 420,467,468,471 (added later on) of IPC, registered at Police Station Narwana Sadar, District Jind (Annexure P-1).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 07.02.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

3. Learned State counsel has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.
