1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.213, dated 13.08.2024, under Sections 420, 406 & 506 of IPC (Sections 467, 468, 471 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Ding, District Sirsa (Annexure P-1).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already deposited a sum of Rs.4,00,000/- in the trial Court in compliance of the order dated 11.02.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.



3. Learned State counsel also submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation. He has also filed status report by way of an affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sirsa and the same is taken on record.

4. In view of the above statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the interim order dated 11.02.2025 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 482 (2) of B.N.S.S.
