1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.61, dated 16.02.2021, under Sections 302, 323, 506, 325 & 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Barauda, Sonipat (Annexure P-1).
