Challenge in the present petition is to the orders dated 05.10.2000 and 15.01.2001 passed by respondent No.3 as well as order dated 30.07.2001 passed by respondent No.5 and order dated 14.12.2001 passed by respondent No.2.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that despite efforts, he has not been successful in obtaining instructions from the petitioner.

Under the given circumstances, it seems that the petitioner may not be interested any further in pursuing the instant writ petition. The same is accordingly dismissed for non-prosecution.
