Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions from the  
quarter concerned, submits that the benefits due to seven of the petitioners  
already stands released, whereas with respect to the remaining three, the  
needful shall be done within one week from today.

[2] In view of the above undertaking, learned counsel for the  
petitioners does not press the present petition any further.

[3] **Dismissed as not pressed.**

[4] However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-  
stated period, as per undertaking, the petitioners would be at liberty to seek  
revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring /  
concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as  
costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioners towards litigation

expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
