1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of certiorari, quashing the order dated 13.09.1999 (Annexure P-7), whereby the claim of the petitioner for assigning him seniority w.e.f. 09.11.1982 i.e. the date on which the petitioner was promoted as Section Officer, has been rejected.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite his best efforts he has not been able to get further instructions from the petitioner.
3. In this view of the matter, the instant petition is dismissed for non-prosecution. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to revive the same in case any cause still survives.
