1. At the very outset, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner fairly submits that during the pendency of the present writ petition, the Government of Punjab has issued a Notification dated 18.02.2025, whereby the employees, like the petitioner, are held entitled for grant of leave encashment. He further submits that in fact, two instalments have already been released to the petitioner and to other similarly situated employees. Learned counsel submits that taking into consideration the abovesaid fact, he does not want to press the present writ petition. However, liberty may be granted to file an application for revival of the same, if any cause survives.

2. In view of the above submission made by learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of as not pressed with liberty abovesaid.

3. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, also stands disposed of.
