“That the applicant/respondent No.1 intends to settle the dispute with the petitioner/Insurance Company and therefore, he would have no objection if the impugned award passed by the Ld. Permanent Lok Adalat Kurukshetra may be modified by this Hon’ble High Court to that extent i.e. holding that the applicant/respondent no.1 entitled for refund of the amount incurred by him on his treatment taken only within India and not outside India for which he will approach the petitioner/Insurance Company alongwith the details of the bills, which may be worked out by it accordingly and the applicant/respondent No.1 would refund the excess principal amount, if any, after setting off his entire claims with the petitioner/Insurance Company, if any.”

5. Notice of the application (CM-13139-2025) to the non-applicant/petitioner.

6. Mr. Satpal Dhamija, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of petitioner and states that he does not have any objection in case the writ petition is disposed of in view of the undertaking given by respondent No.1.

7. In view of the consensus arrived at between the parties, writ petition is disposed of. Impugned award dated 06.12.2021,
