NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. Instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for directing respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner as respondents No.4 to 6 (in-laws of the petitioner) are threatening her to shunting out from her matrimonial home and also force her to give a sum of Rs.1.5 crores if she wants to live in her matrimonial home and even tried to kill her and in this regard complaint/representation dated 10.12.2024 (Annexure P-1) has already been filed before respondent No.2.

2. Learned State counsel submits that during the pendency of the present petition, the petitioner has submitted representation dated 17.05.2025. Thereafter, on 09.06.2025 she recorded her statement before ASI Babita, Police Station Sector 8, Faridabad, stating therein that now she is residing with her in-laws' family and if in future there will any problem then she will make a complaint. She further submits



that on the basis of the said statement, the complaint dated 17.05.2025 has been consigned to the record on 09.06.2025. She submits that in this view of the matter, instant petition has been rendered infructuous.

3. Disposed of as having become infructuous.
