Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members from the hands of respondents No.5 to 8 and to take legal action against them.

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner is a student of BA Honours 2nd year in Lovely Professional University. He submits that the petitioner is a swimmer and on the basis of false and frivolous allegations he is being harassed by the respondent-police officials. He submits that the petitioner earlier filed representation and allegations against him were found to be false. He submits that now again the petitioner is being called by the respondent-police officials despite there being no case having registered against him. He submits that the petitioner has also filed representations (Annexures P-4 and P-6), but the same are also not decided till date.

On the other hand, learned State counsel has drawn the attention of this Court to the reply filed and has submitted that the petitioner is required for enquiry in the allegations of consuming intoxicants. He has submitted that

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though no FIR has been registered so far against the petitioner, however, enquiry etc. would be conducted strictly in accordance with law.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the State to proceed with the enquiry/investigation, if any against the petitioner, strictly in accordance with law. The petitioner would be at liberty to avail his remedy if any further cause of action accrues to him.
