1. Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the official respondents No. 2 and 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and their family members at the hands of private respondents.

2. On 11.02.2025, following order was passed by this Court:

“ Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the official respondents No. 2 and 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and their family members at the hands of private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners inter alia contends that minor son of petitioners namely Abhishek and minor daughter namely Shreya of respondent No.5, ran away together and petitioners-parents of Abhishek are completely unaware of their whereabouts, still local police is harassing them at the instance of respondent No.5.

On advance notice, Mr. Amandeep Singh DAG, Punjab, appears on behalf of respondent(s)/State and prays for some time to file status report.”

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3. Learned State Counsel submits that during the pendency of the instant petition before this Court, the statements of the parties have been recorded. As per the statements, there is currently no apprehension of threat to their life and liberty, as an FIR has already been lodged against the private respondents. Therefore, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

4. In view of the statement made by the learned State Counsel, no specific directions are warranted at this stage. Accordingly, the petition is disposed of, as having become infructuous.
