NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of certiorari, quashing the order dated 27/31.08.2001, whereby the current duty charge assigned to the petitioner has been withdrawn. Further, seeking a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to grant regular promotion to the petitioner w.e.f. the date he was assigned current duty charge on the basis of meeting of D.P.C. held on 13.07.1997, wherein the petitioner has already been held fit for promotion with all consequential benefits including seniority etc.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite his best efforts, he has not been able to get instructions from the petitioner.

3. In this view of the matter, the present petition is dismissed as having not pressed at this stage with liberty to the petitioner to revive the same in case any cause of action still survives.
