SURYA PARTAP SINGH. J.(Oral)

1. This is third bail petition filed by the petitioner on the ground that he has already suffered lot of incarceration for being in custody since 2018.

2. However, a perusal of record shows that on last occasion when the bail petition was moved by the petitioner i.e. CRM-M-40534-2024 an order was passed by learned coordinate Bench of this Court, on 28.08.2024, that the trial be concluded expeditiously.

3. It has been reported by learned State counsel that in view of above mentioned order, the prosecution evidence has already been concluded in this case and after recording the statement of accused under Section 313 Cr.P.C., now the case is fixed for defence evidence. Since the

trial is at final stage and there is no substantial change of circumstances from the date of dismissal of earlier bail petition, there is no merit in the present petition. Hence, the same is hereby dismissed, accordingly.
