1. Petitioner has filed 2nd bail petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. (now 483 of BNSS, 2023) for grant of regular bail in FIR No.20 dated 23.02.2023 under Sections 417, 420, 120-B of IPC and 66(C) of Information Technology Act, 2000 registered at Police Station Shahpurkandi, Pathankot, Punjab.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is in custody since 04.04.2023 and trial will take sufficient time to conclude. He further submits that he is ready to settle the dispute and prayed for regular bail.



3. Learned State counsel submits that out of total 20 witnesses only 07 witnesses have been examined and remaining 13 witnesses are yet to be examined.
4. Learned counsel for the complainant submits that the petitioner duped the complainant with an amount of Rs.50,00,000/- and petitioner has not given any proposal regarding settlement. He further submits that the application for regular bail of the petitioner has already been dismissed by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 12.09.2024 (Annexure P-4) and made prayer for dismissal of the bail application
5. Heard.
6. Keeping in view the contention of counsel for the parties as the bail application of the present petitioner has already been dismissed on merits by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 12.09.2024 (Annexure P-4) and also the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 04.04.2023 i.e. for the last more than 2 years 3 months 25 days, the present petition is hereby disposed of with direction to learned trial Court to conclude the trial expeditiously and not beyond six months from the date of certified copy of this order.
7. Pending application(s), if any, also stands disposed of.
