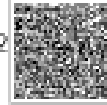
1. By way of filing instant petition, petitioner seeks a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to issue/release the result of the petitioner, who has already cleared the required exams and interview besides the medical test.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that at this juncture the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.5-Regional Director, North West Regional Office, Staff Selection Commission to look into the matter and take a decision with respect to the claim raised by the petitioner in the present writ petition by treating the same as a representation.
