1. The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.498 dated 03.10.2023 registered under Section 376 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 4 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offence Act, 2012 at Police Station Sector 27, Sonipat.
2. Status report by way of an affidavit of Sh. Jeet Singh, HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Kharkohda, District Sonipat, on behalf of the respondent-State, has been filed by learned State Counsel in the Court which is taken on record.
