JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 03.12.2024 (Annexure P-14) whereby his retiral dues have been withheld.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner was wrongly implicated in FIR No.318 dated 07.06.2005 under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 13(1) of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 registered at Police Station City Gurgaon. Trial arising out of aforesaid FIR is pending for more than 15 years. There is no delay on the part of petitioner still he is deprived of his retiral dues.

3. On the request of this Court, learned Additional Sessions Judge, Gurugram has sent her report which confirms that there are 17 accused in the



aforesaid FIR. There were 77 witnesses and all the witnesses have already been either examined or given up. The case is almost mature.

4. In the wake of report of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Gurugram, I do not find it appropriate to interfere with the impugned order dated 03.12.2024 (Annexure P-14) at this stage.

5. Dismissed.

6. Needless to say, the petitioner would be entitled to all retiral dues if he is acquitted in the aforesaid trial.
