MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus, seeking directions to the official respondents to get released Harmandeep Kaur, wife of the petitioner, from the illegal custody of respondents No.4 to 8.

2. Reply by way of affidavit of Jasjyot Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Jagraon, District Ludhiana (Rural), on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3, has been filed in the Court today which is taken on record subject to all just exceptions. A copy of the same has been supplied to the counsel opposite.

3. In compliance of order dated 13.02.2025, report from learned CJM, Ludhiana, has been received wherein the father of the alleged detainee has categorically stated that the alleged detainee is not



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in India and has been living in Canada since 29.07.2023 and hence, the detinue was not produced before the learned CJM.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, has controverted the statement made by father of the detinue before the learned CJM, and has submitted to the contrary. He submits that the alleged detinue could not have left the shores of India as her original passport is with the petitioner.

5. This Court would refrain from commenting upon the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner.

6. The instant petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus, which stands disposed of in view of the report of the learned CJM, Ludhiana.
