1. The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.13 dated 19.01.2025 registered under Sections 64 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 at Police Station Sadar, District Patiala.
2. As per office report, respondent No.2 has been duly served, however, none has put in appearance on her behalf.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 13.02.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.
4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Baljinder Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation on 15.02.2025, however, he is required to be medically examined.

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5. Learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection for the medical examination of the petitioner and submitted that the petitioner shall visit the Investigating Officer as and when called.

6. In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 13.02.2025 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of Cr.P.C./482(2) of BNSS, 2023.
