Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to learned Additional Sessions Judge, Jind to decide the criminal revision petition (CRR No.22-2024) in FIR No.44 dated 18.02.2024, under Section 61 of Excise Act, Section 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Narwana filed by the respondent challenging order dated 13.05.2024 passed by learned JMIC, Narwana, whereby the Superdari application filed by the petitioner was dismissed.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner filed an application for superdari of the property which was confiscated during the investigation. He submits that as the property in question is perishable item, learned Revisional Court be directed to decide the criminal revision expeditiously. He further submits that the case is already at the stage of arguments and is fixed for 21.02.2025.
