1. The present petition has been filed for issuance of necessary directions to the official respondents No.2 to 5 to take appropriate steps against respondents No.6 to 8 and to take action on his representation dated 27.12.2024 (Annexure P-3).

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has filed an representation on 27.12.2024 before the Senior Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana (Annexure P-3) raising their grievances as mentioned in the present petition but the same has not yet been considered and no action has been taken thereon. He further submitted that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 3- Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to decide the aforesaid representation filed by the petitioner and take necessary action thereon.

3. Notice of motion.

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4. Ms. Sakshi Bakshi, AAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, has accepted the notice on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that the needful will be done in due course. Let a complete set of the paperbook be supplied to her during the course of the day.

5. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No. 3 to decide the aforesaid representation dated 27.12.2024 (Annexure P-3) of the petitioner within a period of one month, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.
