Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.84, dated 17.07.2024, under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sultanwind, District Amritsar.

Vide order dated 15.02.2025, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in pursuance to the order passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI, Gurcharan Singh (Pairvi), has stated that petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 15.02.2025 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS, 2023. Petition stands allowed.
