The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India *inter alia* for issuing directions to respondents No.2 to 4 to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-3), submitted by the petitioner giving the details of criminal antecedents of respondent No.5 and also his unauthorized possession on the panchayat land.

2. On advance service of copy of petition, Mr. Nirmaljit Singh Diwana, Sr. DAG, Punjab appears on behalf of the respondent/State of Punjab.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from Mr. Subash Chander, Panchayat Officer, Block-1, Hoshiarpur, submits that the allegations as regards the criminal antecedents and also the unauthorized possession over the panchayat land were inquired into by the authorities, however, no substance was found therein, accordingly, the complaint/representation (Annexure P-3), submitted by the petitioner



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already stands closed.

- 4. In view of the aforesaid stand taken by learned State counsel, no further orders are required to be passed in the instant writ petition, therefore the same is accordingly disposed of.
- 5. All pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
