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Ms. Monika Jalota, Advocate appears and files Vakalatnama on behalf of the respondents-PSEB. The same is taken on record.

The present writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed by M/s Nancy Packages P. Ltd seeking quashing of order dated 21.08.2001 (Annexure P-3), seeking direction to respondent No.3 to release M.S. connection to his application dated 18.03.2001 and to stay the said impugned order (Annexure P-3) with direction to give provisional connection.

The writ petition was admitted on 01.05.2002.

The present writ petition has been assigned to this Forum for the purpose of settlement. Notices were issued to the parties and Er. Karamjit Singh, SDO, City Sub Division PSPCL Samana appeared and wanted time to bring the petitioner to be present before this Forum. Since the petitioner did not appear, he was asked to file affidavit of the petitioner duly attested by the notary, indicating that he does not wish to pursue the present writ petition vide order dated 08.10.2025.

By virtue of said order, Er. Karamjit Singh, SDO, has filed the affidavit of the petitioner-Sham Jindal, Director Nancy Paper Products Pvt. Ltd. Samana, duly attested by notary, which has been taken on record as Mark 'A'. In the said affidavit, he categorically states that he does not wish to pursue the present writ petition and has no objection if the writ petition is closed.

In view of the said affidavit of the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as infructuous.
