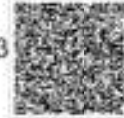

SUDEEPTI SHARMA J. (Oral)

1. The present contempt petition has been filed for deliberate and intentional disobedience of order dated 10.09.2019 passed by this Court in CWP-23375-2017, whereby, the following direction was given by this Court:-

“12. Petitioner is entitled to minimum of the pay scale with effect from the date of his joining till date as his services were continued as Peon vide order dated 23.01.2018, passed by this Court. However, the arrears of salary are confined to 38 months prior to filing of the writ petition along with interest @6% per annum.”



2. In compliance of order dated 10.09.2019 passed by this Court in CWP-23375-2017, compliance affidavit of Sh. Malkit Singh S/o Sh. Gurbaksh Singh, Zonal Manager, Punjab and Sind Bank, Zonal Office, 5th Floor Bhai Bala Chowk, Ludhiana, dated 17.05.2025 has already been filed and the same is taken on record.

3. A perusal of the para 3 and 4 of the compliance affidavit of Sh. Malkit Singh S/o Sh. Gurbaksh Singh shows that order dated 10.09.2019 is complied with.

4. In view of the above, the contempt is purged and rule is discharged.

5. Pending application(s), if any, also stand disposed of.

6. Liberty is however granted to the petitioner to approach the respondents for the remaining relief if any. The respondents are expected to do the needful expeditiously, thereafter.
